### Project outcomes

1. Integrated sanitation solutions for water protection
2. Decentralized wastewater management for communities, schools, traditional markets and hospitals
3. Solid waste management systems for communities, schools and traditional markets
4. Institutional and community capacity building

### Project Interventions

1. Capacity Building and policy development for water and sanitation planning in densely populated areas
2. Workshops and assistances in Operational and Maintenance (OM) of sanitation infrastructures
3. Field visit for the ISA stakeholders to implemented sanitation best practices
4. Piloting "livable neighborhoods"
5. Feasibility study for Faecal Sludge Management (FSM) on regional scale (identification of suitable locations) and Assistance and Facilitation of FSM facility implementation
6. Introduction to advance sanitation infrastructure (user friendly, economic, good quality) for community and boarding school
7. Enforcement of new water and sanitation regulations
8. Awareness raising and education campaigns for communities and stimulation/trigger actions on the importance of sanitation program in community settlement
